TOURNAMENT STYLE AND GAME FORMAT:

This is a double elimination tournament. An "If Game" will be played, if necessary.

Drawing for team position will be held Wednesday, November 10th. Registered teams will be notified Monday, November 8th with time and location of draw.

Tournament will begin Sunday, November 14th.

Championship game will be played Sunday, November 21st.

A team trophy and individual player trophies will be given for 1st and 2nd place. All players will receive a tournament T-shirt.

All games will be played at Indian Bowl.

SPECIAL RULES & REGULATIONS:

The Rougher Rumble follows the Oklahoma Secondary School's Rules and Regulations, with the exceptions set forth below.

LENGTH OF GAME & SCORING RULES:

- Games will consist of four (4) quarters. Each quarter will last eight (8) minutes with a ten (10) minute halftime break.
- A touchdown is worth 6 points, an extra point (run or pass is = 1 point, kick is = 2 points).
- Stopping the Clock in Championship Game
 - Oklahoma Secondary School's Rules will be followed
- Stopping the Clock in Tournament Games
 - After a Touchdown or Field Goal and will resume at Kick Off
 - If at any time the score difference of 35 points is reached the clock will then run continuous and the score will be frozen.
 - Last 2 minutes of the 4th quarter Oklahoma Secondary School's Rules will be followed.
 - Two (2 min) Timeouts per Half
- Overtime Tiebreaker for Championship Games
 - Oklahoma Secondary School's Rules will be followed.
- Overtime Tiebreaker for Tournament Games
 - After the coin toss options, play will start at the defensive team's 25-yard line.
 - Each team will have one series of downs, 1st and goal, starting at the 25-yard line.
 - Teams cannot make a 1st down or be awarded an automatic 1st down.
 - If a defensive team penalty is accepted, the down will be replayed.
 - If an offensive team penalty is accepted, the down will be replayed unless the penalty carries a loss of down.
 - Whichever team has the highest score or the most penetration distance after 4 downs and maintains possession for all 4 downs, wins the game.
 - If both teams have lost yardage after 4 downs, or have lost possession, or have the same score or penetration, the overtime will be replayed.
- Center protected on declared punts, field goals and extra points. Defense cannot make contact with the center until such time as the ball touches the kicker, offensive player or the ground.

AGE LIMITS:

7th Grade >> Player can't be age 14 before 9/1/10.

WEIGHT LIMITS:

Grade	One Striper	Maximum
7th	160 #	none

All players shall be required to weigh in one hour prior to their first game.

STRIPED PLAYERS:

One Stripers:

1. Cannot have more than 3 one striped players on the field of play at any one time. They can advance a fumble or pass interception but may not return a punt.
2. Can only be in a down position in a 3 or 4 point stance.

One Stripers- Offense:

1. Must play on the interior offensive line and may never be in a position to be eligible for a pass.

NOTE: On an unbalanced line, the tackle becomes an end if uncovered making him illegal.

One Stripers-Defense:

1. Must play on the defensive line and will not lineup any wider than head up with tight end's normal position whether a tight end is lined up on that side or not.

One Stripers-Special Teams:

1. Cannot be on Kick Off or Kick Return Teams.
2. Punt and PAT formations must follow Offense and Defense Rules

CONDUCT POLICY:

- No intimidation of any kind, on or off the field
- No trash talking

Officials have been advised to remove players from the game for two (2) plays for the FIRST OFFENSE, with a 15 yard penalty. The player will be removed from the game and asked to leave the premises on the SECOND OFFENSE.

As a Head Coach it is your responsibility to control the parents attending this event. Any incident involving parents or fans of your team may be asked to leave the field for unruly conduct. We reserve the right to stop the play of a game and forfeit the team's game.

There must be a Head or Assistant Coach present at the weigh in. Please line players up as numbered on your Team's Roster.
