INFC Rules on Protection

<u>Section 13 Article 3:</u> Team Drafts- Upon origination (1st year) a team may recruit and protect four (4) players from the draft. Each year thereafter, the team will be allowed to recruit and protect two (2) new players. The protected players cannot have played for another INFC team the previous year. This provision does not, however, eliminate the requirement that teams be of equal ability. At any time one team splits to two or more teams, all players will be in the draft pool except the 4 protected players.

Section 13 Article 8: Team Drafts- Before leaving the draft table, coaches will be allowed to trade players but only those players selected during the draft. Existing players are tradeable if approved by the INFC Rep and the drafting drafting club's Officer. Protected players are not tradeable. Any and all player trades made after the selection of players must be approved by the INFC monitoring representative prior to finalization of the draft and team rosters Section 13(b) Article 3- A player that leaves an organization but returns the following year shall be in the draft and can not be protected. A player who is drafted prior to leaving the team will still be the property of the team from which he was drafted the previous year.

Players that are granted INFC transfers must be placed in the draft and may not be protected.

Players who have previously played in the INFC, leave, and then return shall not be allowed protection status to a team unless the player in question has been absent, undrafted, and has not played an INFC participating Club for a minimum of 2 years.

An INFC player requesting protection status that has previously played outside his normal grade level must have played outside his grade level for a minimum of not less than 2 years before protection status shall be granted.
